Immediate Implant Placement w/Provisionalization: The Single Tooth Solution

Description

Thought- Provoking Treatment Planning for the Edentulous Patient

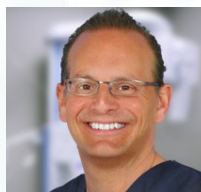
Description
